BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 10-3-312, MCA, is amended to read:

"10-3-312. Maximum expenditure by governor -app:coriation. (1) Whenever an emergency or disaster is
declared by the governor, there is statutorily appropriated
to the office of the governor, as provided in 17-7-502, and
he is authorized to expend from the general fund, an amount
not to exceed \$2 million in any biennium. In the event of
the recovery of money expended under this section, the
spending authority must be reinstated to a level reflecting
the recovery.

(2) If a disaster is declared by the president of the United States, there is statutorily appropriated to the office of the governor, as provided in 17-7-502, and he is authorized to expend from the general fund, an amount not to exceed \$500,000 during the biennism to meet the state's

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

The bill would require that the emergency or disaster fund be replenished in an amount equal to the amount recovered for expenditures under the disaster and emergency services laws.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- The Department of Military Affairs may recover appropriate expenditures under this section of the law.
- All amounts recovered will be deposited to the general fund in the same manner as under current law.
- Other agencies may be responsible for recovering expenditures made by the Department of Military Affairs.
- 4. The bill will have no fiscal impact other than restoring statutory appropriation authority for amounts recovered from other sources.
