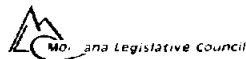
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** Appropriation. (1) There is

appropriated from the general fund to the superintendent of public instruction \$2.5 million for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, for grants to school districts that experience a disaster that destroys school property to the extent of rendering the property unfit for its present school use.

(2) The superintendent of public instruction shall prioritize the award of grants to assist districts that demonstrate the greatest need for assistance in replacing school property that has been destroyed as a result of a disaster.

17, CHAPTER 5, PART 16.

(2) The superintendent of public instruction shall
prioritize the award of grants to assist districts that
demonstrate the greatest need for assistance in replacing
school property that has been destroyed as a result of a
disaster.
