BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 49-4-304, MCA, is amended to read:

"49-4-304. Special license plate or card to be provided and displayed — additional cards allowed for owners of more than one vehicle. (1) The department of justice shall provide a special license plate under 61-3-445 or a card to be displayed on or in a motor vehicle to indicate a parking privilege granted under this part. The special license plate shall must be affixed to the vehicle according to 61-3-301, or the card shall must be prominently displayed in the windshield of a vehicle when the parking privilege is being used by the handicapped person in a vehicle other than the one to which his special license plate is affixed.

(2) Subject to the provisions of 49-4-301 through 49-4-305, a person who is eligible to receive a special parking permit and who owns more than one motor vehicle may request and the department of justice shall provide to him

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0646, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act allowing additional parking privilege display cards to be issued to a handicapped person who owns more than one motor vehicle.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. There are 15,000 cards currently issued, one to a person. Each person would purchase, on the average, one more card in FY92. Thereafter each new applicant would purchase two cards.
- 2. Printing, postage and handling costs about \$1 per card.
- 3. Current law is represented by the executive budget recommendation for the Registrar's Bureau of the Department of Justice.
