## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act allowing additional parking privilege display cards to be issued to a handicapped person who owns more than one motor vehicle.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Ther. ate 15,000 cards currently issued, one to a person. Each person would purchase, on the average, one more card in FYo2. Thereafter each new applicant would purchase two cards.
2. Printing, postage and handling costs about $\$ 1$ per card.
3. Current law is represented by the executive budget recommendation for the Registrar's Bureau of the Department of Justice.

Section 1. Section 49-4-304, MCA, is amended to read:
"49-4-304. Special license plate or card to be providこd and displayed -- additional cards allowed for owners of more than one vehicle. (1) The department of justice shall provide a special license plate under 61-3-445 or a card to be displayed on or in a motor vehicle to indicate a parking privilege granted under this part. The special license plate shałł must be affixed to the vehicle according to 61-3-301, or the card shazt must be prominently displayed in the windshield of a vehicle when the parking privilege is being used by the handicapped person in a vehicle other than the one to which his special license plate is affixed.
