 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Evergreen wastewater  
 11 facilities project loan reauthorization -- transfer of  
 12 authority. (1) The legislature finds that the Evergreen  
 13 wastewater facilities project for which coal severance tax  
 14 bonds were authorized to be issued by the 51st legislature  
 15 in House Bill No. 778, Laws of 1989, may not complete the  
 16 requirements necessary for the loan transaction prior to  
 17 June 30, 1991. Authority established in House Bill No. 778,  
 18 Laws of 1989, to issue coal severance tax bonds for the  
 19 Evergreen water and sewer district, wastewater facilities  
 20 project, in the amount of \$3,226,900 is continued to enable  
 21 financing during the 1992-93 biennium, if necessary.  
 22 Interest must be at the rates authorized by the 51st  
 23 legislature in House Bill No. 778, Laws of 1989.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Evergreen wastewater facilities project loan reauthorization -- transfer of authority. (1) The legislature finds that the Evergreen wastewater facilities project for which coal severance tax bonds were authorized to be issued by the 51st legislature in House Bill No. 778, Laws of 1989, may not complete the requirements necessary for the loan transaction prior to June 30, 1991. Authority established in House Bill No. 778, Laws of 1989, to issue coal severance tax bonds for the Evergreen water and sewer district, wastewater facilities project, in the amount of \$3,226,900 is continued to enable financing during the 1992-93 biennium, if necessary. Interest must be at the rates authorized by the 51st legislature in House Bill No. 778, Laws of 1989.

(2) The loan reauthorized in this section may be made to Flathead County on behalf of rural special improvement
