#### STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0732, as introduced.

### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill to require secured loads on vehicles; increasing the penalty for illegal dumping; and dedicating fines collected to a county account to fund prosecutions of violations.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. In FY90, 33 summons were issued by the Highway Patrol. The number of summons that will be issued in FY92 and FY93 is subject to considerable variation. The amount of collections is variable due to judicial discretion to suspend or reduce fines.
- 2. A minor increase in collections is likely but is inestimable. Deposits to the general fund in the event that collections in a county account exceed \$5,000 are unlikely.
- 3. Increases in workload associated with prosecutions for county attorneys is expected to be negligible.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

None.

### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUE OR EXPENDITURES:

Fines collected would be deposited to a county account to defray costs of prosecutions by the county attorney.
