#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act requiring the state to erect a monument and flag circle at the capitol complex to honor American Indians.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The appropriation and private contributions will be adequate to complete the American Indian Monument.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

None in the 1993 biennium.

### LONG-RANGE EFFECTS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

American Indian Monument will require annual maintenance similar to Capitol flower display. All state agencies located on the capitol campus will be charged approximately \$0.01 or less per square foot for this purpose in future years.
