In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0764, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act reserving 2 cents of the 18 cent cigarette tax deposited to the long-range building program fund for the construction, operation and maintenance of state veterans' nursing homes.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. This proposal would become effective October 1, 1991.
- 2. Under current law cigarette tax is allocated as follows: 70.89% long-range building debt service fund type; 29.11% long-range building capital projects fund type.
- 3. Under the proposal cigarette tax is allocated as follows: 70.89% long-range building debt service fund type; 18.01% long-range building capital projects fund type; 11.10% long-range building capital fund type reserved for the constructions, operation and maintenance of state veterans' nursing homes.
- 4. Under the proposal, there would be three months at the current allocation and 9 months at the proposed allocation in FY92.
