8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** HIV-related testing for person
 10 charged with sexual offense. The court shall order a person
 11 against whom a prosecution has been commenced for any sexual
 12 offense, as defined in 46-23-502, involving nonconsensual
 13 sexual intercourse to submit to an HIV-related test, as
 14 defined in 50-16-1003. The results of the test must be
 15 reported to the court. The court shall disclose the results
 16 to any victim of the sexual offense who requests the
 17 disclosure. Review and disclosure of the blood test results
 18 by the court must be closed and confidential, and any
 19 records relating to the blood test and its results must also
 20 be closed and confidential.
