13 may establish or recognize one or more search and rescue  
14 units within the county.

15 (2) Except in time of martial rule as provided in  
16 10-1-106, search and rescue units and their officers are  
17 under the operational control and supervision of the county  
18 sheriff, or his designee, having jurisdiction and whose span  
19 of control would be considered within reasonable limits.

20 (3) A county may, after approval by a majority of the  
21 people voting on the question at an election held throughout  
22 the county, levy an annual tax of not more than 1 mill on  
23 each dollar of taxable value of all taxable property within  
24 the county to support one or more search and rescue units  
25 established or recognized under subsection (1)."
