(1) The 13 department shall adopt rules regulating special wild buffalo 14 licenses. The rules shall provide for: 15 (a) license drawing procedures based on a year-round 16 17 season; (b) an entry fee for the drawing of a license, which 18 must be a minimum of \$5; 19 (c) notification of license recipients as to when and 20 where they may hunt; 21 (d) means of taking; 22 (e) tagging requirements for carcasses, skulls, and 23 24 hides; (f) possession limits; and 25

3	hunter who has purchased a special wild buffalo license

7	bull is available is entitled to \$100 of the original \$200
8	license fee;
