Each insurer authorized to effect insurance on risks enumerated in 19-11-512 doing business in this state shall pay to the state auditor and commissioner of insurance ex officio during the month of February or March in each year, in addition to the taxes on premiums required by law to be paid by it, a tax of 3/4-of-1% 1.5% on the fire portion of the direct premiums on such risks received during the calendar year next preceding after deducting cancellations and return



premiums. A fire prevention and investigation account is
created in the state special revenue fund. The proceeds of
the tax imposed by this section must be deposited in the
fire prevention and investigation account. Money deposited
in the account may be appropriated by the legislature to
fund the fire prevention and investigation activities of the
department of justice."

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0809, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act increasing the tax on fire insurance premiums for maintenance of state fire prevention and investigation activities.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The amount of fire insurance premium taxes collected under 50-3-109, MCA, was approximately \$470,000 in FY90. Assuming a 2% per year average increase in fire insurance premiums, the amount of taxes collected and deposited to the general fund at the current rate will be \$479,000 in FY92 and \$489,000 in FY93.
- 2. The current tax rate for fire marshal operations is 0.75% and the proposed rate in this bill is 1.50%.
- 3. A new fire prevention and investigation account is established.
