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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-5-153, MCA, is amended to read: 10

MACHINE: AND AMENDING SECTION 23-5-153, MCA."

"23-5-153. Possession and sale of antique slot machines. (1) For the purposes of this section, an antique slot machine is a mechanically or electronically operated slot machine that-at-any-present-time-is-more-than-25-years old manufactured before January 1, 1965.

- (2) Except as provided in subsection (3), an antique slot machine may be possessed, located, and operated only in private residential dwelling or in a commercial establishment engaged in the buying and selling of antique slot machines.
- (3) (a) An antique slot machine may be possessed or 21 located for purposes of display only and not for operation 22 23 in any public museum owned and operated by the state, a 24 county, or a city.
  - (b) A-licensed-manufacturer-distributor-may-possess-and
