4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING THE PROVISIONS
5 PERTAINING TO THE POSSESSION AND SALE OF ANTIQUE SLOT
6 MACHINES; REVISING THE DEFINITION OF AN ANTIQUE SLOT
7 MACHINE; AND AMENDING SECTION 23-5-153, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 23-5-153, MCA, is amended to read:

11 **"23-5-153. Possession and sale of antique slot**
12 **machines.** (1) For the purposes of this section, an antique
13 slot machine is a mechanically or electronically operated
14 slot machine ~~that-at-any-present-time-is-more-than-25-years~~
15 ~~old~~ manufactured before January 1, 1965.

16 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3), an antique
17 slot machine may be possessed, located, and operated only in
18 a private residential dwelling or in a commercial
19 establishment engaged in the buying and selling of antique
20 slot machines.

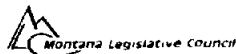
21 (3) (a) An antique slot machine may be possessed or
22 located for purposes of display only and not for operation
23 in any public museum owned and operated by the state, a
24 county, or a city.

25 (b) ~~A-licensed-manufacturer-distributor-may-possess-and~~

1 ~~sell-antique-slot--machines~~ A person possessing a valid
2 business license in this state may possess antique slot
3 machines for the purpose of commercially selling the
4 machines.

5 (4) An antique slot machine may not be operated for any
6 commercial or charitable purpose."
