4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE BOARD OF
 5 PUBLIC EDUCATION, UPON RECOMMENDATION FROM THE OFFICE OF
 6 PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, TO ADOPT RULES REQUIRING SCHOOLS TO
 7 OFFER COURSES IN NATIVE AMERICAN HISTORY AND CULTURE FOR
 8 ACCREDITATION PURPOSES; TO REQUIRE EDUCATORS TO OBTAIN
 9 CREDITS IN NATIVE AMERICAN HISTORY OR CULTURE FOR
 10 RECERTIFICATION PURPOSES; TO REQUIRE THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC
 11 INSTRUCTION TO DEVELOP CURRICULA IN NATIVE AMERICAN HISTORY
 12 AND CULTURE; AND PROVIDING A DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

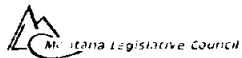

 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Board to adopt rules relating
 16 to Native American history and culture. (1) The board of
 17 public education, upon recommendation from the office of
 18 public instruction, shall adopt rules requiring schools to
 19 offer courses in Native American history and culture for
 20 accreditation purposes and requiring educators to obtain
 21 credits in Native American history or culture for
 22 recertification purposes.

23 (2) The office of public instruction shall develop
 24 curricula for courses in Native American history and culture
 25 pursuant to rules adopted by the board under subsection ().

1 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is
 2 effective July 1, 1992.
