BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 14

15 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Board to adopt rules relating to Native American history and culture. (1) The board of 16 17 public education, upon recommendation from the office of 18 public instruction, shall adopt rules requiring schools to offer courses in Native American history and culture for 20 accreditation purposes and requiring educators to obtain 21 credits in Native American history or culture for 22 recertification purposes.

(2) The office of public instruction shall develop curricula for courses in Native American history and culture pursuant to rules adopted by the board under subsection ( ).
