4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE 5 CITIZENS' ADVOCATE PROGRAM FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE TO THE 6 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL; APPROPRIATING MONEY; AND PROVIDING AN 7 EFFECTIVE DATE."

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9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. Citizens' advocate program ---11 functions. (1) The legislative council shall operate and 12 maintain a citizens' advocate program.

program is (2) Access to the citizens' advocate 13 14 provided to the citizens of Montana and their elected 15 representatives through the operation of toll-free telephone access and other appropriate technology. The program shall 16 17 provide information and referral to assist citizens in identifying the correct person or program to serve their 18 need. The citizens' advocate program may assist in resolving 19 20 problems through referral or direct intervention. The 21 program may provide central access to state government for a 22 program or activity that requires toll-free access.

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Assets transferred. The 24 personnel, full-time equivalent authority, equipment, 25 telephone number assignment, supplies, and space allocated

1 to the citizens' advocate office operated in the governor's 2 office under executive order are transferred to the 3 legislative council for the use of the citizens' advocate 4 program.

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Appropriation. The following 6 amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the 7 legislative council for the operation of the citizens' 8 advocate program:

- 9 FY 1992 \$70,526
- 10 FY 1993 71,205

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Coordination instruction. An appropriation in House Bill No. 2 for program 16, citizens' advocate office, in agency 3101, the governor's office, is rescinded.

NEW SECTION. Section 5. Effect of appropriation on current level base. The appropriation to the legislative council in [section 3] is part of the current level base for purposes of budget submission and analysis under Title 17, chapter 7, part 1.

NEW SECTION. Section 6. Codification instruction.
[Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part
of Title 5, chapter 11, and the provisions of Title 5,
chapter 11, apply to [section 1].

24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 7. Effective date. [This act] is
25 effective July 1, 1991.
