DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to require the representation of organized labor on the State Employee Group Benefits Advisory Council; and amending 2-15-1016, MCA.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The proposed legislation would limit representation to labor organizations defined in 39-31-103, MCA, which represent more than 1,000 state employees.
- 2. According to the State Personnel Division Labor Relations Status Report #25 dated December 10, 1990, two labor organizations would meet the proposed criteria.
- 3. The advisory council meets six times per year. The added member would be entitled to the \$25 per day honorarium authorized in 2-15-122, MCA.
- 4. The additional cost will be absorbed in the recommended operating budget.
