Section 20-7-504, MCA, is amended to read: 13 "20-7-504. State traffic education account -- proceeds 14 earmarked for the account. (1) There is a traffic education 15 account in the treasury of the state of Montana. There shall 16 be is paid into this account all or a portion of the fines 17 and forfeitures collected in any court except a justice's 18 court from persons apprehended or arrested by highway patrol 19 officers or, department of highways peace officers, or 20 police officers, as provided in subsection (2), for any 21 22 violation of chapter 3, part 1 of chapter 4, or chapters 5 through 10 of Title 61 relating to the operation or use of 23 24 motor vehicles in the following amounts: 25 (a) if a fine is imposed, 25% of the fine imposed;

1 (b) if multiple offenses are involved, 25% of the total 2 sum of all fines imposed; 3 (c) if a fine is suspended, in whole or in part, 25% of 4 the fine actually paid; and 5 (d) if any deposit of bail is made for an offense to 6 which this section applies and the bail is forfeited, 25% of 7 the forfeited bail. 8 (2) If a fine is imposed or if bail is forfeited in a 9 municipal or city court from a person apprehended by a 10 police officer under the provisions of 61-8-401 or 61-8-714, 11 100% of the fine imposed or bail forfeited must be paid to 12 the traffic education account. 13 (2) (3) A portion of all money from the collection of 14 fees from driver's licenses, motorcycle endorsements, and 15 duplicate driver's licenses shall must be contributed to the 16 traffic education account as provided in 61-5-121." Section 2. Section 25-30-102, MCA, is amended to read: 17 "25-30-102. Fees and fines. The fees and fines in 18 municipal court shall-be are the same as the fees and fines 19 20 provided by law or ordinance, and except as provided in 21 20-7-504, all fees and fines collected by the court shall 22 must be paid into the city treasury." -End-
