Section 1. State epidemiologist 12 appointment -- duties. (1) The director of the department of 13 health and environmental sciences shall designate as the 14 state epidemiologist a department employee who has a 15 doctoral degree in epidemiology or other appropriate 16 discipline. 17

(2) The department shall, under the supervision of the 18 state epidemiologist, establish and manage a program of 19 epidemiology for the following purposes: 20

(a) maintaining surveillance of incidence of diseases 21 hazardous to public health; 22

(b) investigating occurrence of diseases to determine 23 risk to public health; 24

(c) promoting appropriate control measures in response 25



1 to epidemic occurrence of diseases and implementing those control measures that are required by state law; 2

3 (d) implementing and coordinating routine preventive 4 measures on a statewide basis necessary to protect public 5 health:

(e) providing standard diagnostic and therapeutic 6 information in the evaluation and management of diseases 7 8 actually or potentially hazardous to public health;

(f) cooperating with other local, state, and federal q, 10 offices and programs in investigating and controlling 11 diseases hazardous to public health; and

12 (g) providing information to the public concerning 13 diseases hazardous to public health.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Appropriation. 14 There is 15 appropriated \$50,000 from the general fund to the department 16 of health and environmental sciences for the biennium ending 17 June 30, 1993. The appropriation must be used by the department for the purposes of [section 1] and to employ 18 19 support staff for the epidemiological program required by 20 [section 1].

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification 21 instruction. 22 [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part 23 of Title 50, and the provisions of Title 50 apply to [section 1]. 24
