10 WHEREAS, [LC 801] establishes a goal of reducing the
 11 volume of solid waste landfilled or incinerated in the state
 12 by 25%; and

13 WHEREAS, source reduction and recycling conserve scarce
 14 landfill space and energy; and

15 WHEREAS, state government is developing source reduction
 16 and recycling programs for state offices and procurement
 17 guidelines for the purchase of materials and supplies made
 18 from recycled material.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
 21 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

22 That local governments in the state be encouraged to
 23 develop source reduction and recycling programs for county
 24 and municipal office buildings.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that local governments in the

1 state be encouraged to adopt procurement guidelines for the
 2 purchase of materials and supplies made from recycled
 3 material.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State send
 5 a copy of this resolution to the executive officer of each
 6 county and incorporated community in the state.

9 SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS in the state.
