 17 decreased by 18% for fiscal year 1991; and

18 WHEREAS, five of the top seven states whose Title III  
 19 funds were decreased are western states that continue to  
 20 suffer from the effects of the oil recession; and

21 WHEREAS, although the amount of Title III funds  
 22 available to the United States Department of Labor for  
 23 discretionary uses increased by \$14 million for fiscal year  
 24 1991, the total decrease in the amount of Title III funds  
 25 equaled \$17.8 million.

 20 dislocated workers, Montana's share of Title III funds was  
 21 decreased by 18% for fiscal year 1991; and

22 WHEREAS, five of the top seven states whose Title III  
 23 funds were decreased are western states that continue to

1 WHEREAS, MONTANA'S DISLOCATED WORKER PROGRAM WAS  
 2 DEVELOPED AS AN EXEMPLARY PROGRAM THAT HAS SERVED AS A MODEL  
 3 FOR PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED IN OTHER STATES; AND

4 WHEREAS, SECTION 322(A)(2) OF THE JOB TRAINING  
 5 PARTNERSHIP ACT PROVIDES FOR THE ALLOCATION OF TITLE III  
 6 RESERVE FUNDS FOR EXEMPLARY DISLOCATED WORKER PROGRAMS; AND

7 WHEREAS, although the amount of Title III funds  
 8 available to the United States Department of Labor for  
 9 discretionary uses increased by \$14 million for fiscal year  
 10 1991, the total decrease in the amount of Title III funds  
 11 equaled \$17.8 million.

 23 STATES SENATE AND UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,  
 24 AND EACH MEMBER OF MONTANA'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION.
