A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA RECOGNIZING THE ACUTE AND COMPLEX NATURE OF CERTAIN ISSUES IMPAIRING THE SUSTAINABILTY OF MONTANA COUNTIES AND COMMUNITIES; RECOGNIZING THE NEED FOR APPLIED RESEARCH TO ANALYZE THESE ISSUES IN SUPPORT OF SOUND PUBLIC POLICY; ENDORSING THE ROLE OF THE MONTANA LOCAL GOVERNMENT POLICY COUNCIL AS AN APPROPRIATE AGENCY TO SPONSOR AND CONDUCT APPLIED PUBLIC POLICY RESEARCH CONCERNING LOCAL GOVERNMENT ISSUES; ANTICIPATING SIGNIFICANT POLICY CONTRIBUTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS BY THE MONTANA LOCAL GOVERNMENT POLICY COUNCIL; AND COMMENDING THE NORTHWEST AREA FOUNDATION FOR ITS ENABLING SUPPORT.

WHEREAS, Montana's local government officials and the communities they serve are confronted with a complex array of issues threatening the well-being of their people and the sustainability of their communities; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that both state and local policymakers need applied policy research in order to formulate sound public policy dealing with such acute local issues as solid waste management, infrastructure renewal,

and cooperative service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Local Government Policy Council has been established by the Local Government Center at Montana State University, with funding support from the Northwest Area Foundation, to sponsor and conduct applied policy research concerning local government issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

(1) That the Legislature endorse the role of the Montana Local Government Policy Council as an appropriate agency to sponsor and conduct applied public policy research concerning local government issues.

(2) That the Legislature anticipate significant policy contributions and recommendations from the Montana Local Government Policy Council.

(3) That the Legislature commend the Northwest Area Foundation for making the work of the Montana Local Government Policy Council possible.

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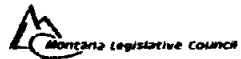
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
