# STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

# Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0003, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill repeals the July 1, 1991, sunset date for the Agricultural Counseling and Mediation Program.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. There will be approximately 100 requests for peer counseling per year.
- 2. Peer counselors will be paid \$5 per hour, plus expenses at state rates. The average cost per peer counseling case will equal \$150. (20 hours per case)
- 3. These will be approximately 30 requests for financial consulting per year.
- 4. Mediators will be paid \$20 per hour, plus expenses at state rates. The average cost per mediation case will equal \$525. (20 hours, 300 miles travel)
- 5. Financial consultants will be paid \$600, plus mileage at the state rate, per case. The average cost per financial consultant case will equal \$650. (200 miles)
- 6. The average fee collected per mediation case will be \$225 and the average fee collected per financial consultant case will be \$100.
- 7. The program will continue to contract with SCORE and the Montana Association of Churches to conduct peer counseling and continue to contract with WIFE to answer approximately 700 telephone calls per year during non-business hours.
- 8. FmHA and other creditors will initiate debt mediation for approximately 100 borrowers per year.
- 9. Montana Mediation Program will retain federal certification and matching federal grant funds. The federal grant guidelines will continue to allow FmHa and other fees collected to be used for part of the state match.
- 10. It will be possible to train mediators sufficiently to meet federal certification requirements.
- 11. The indirect department expenses are not included in the proposed law expenditures, but are estimated in determining proposed federal match, which is computed using 75% of the direct general fund budget plus the fees collected.
