2	(2) Cabooses shall must be at least 24 feet in length,
3	exclusive of platforms, and shall must be provided with a
4	door in each end and with cupolas or bay windows, platforms,
5	guardrails, grabirons, and steps for the safety of persons
6	in alighting or getting on cabooses. Cabooses shall must be
7	of metal frame construction and be sufficiently insulated to
8	eliminate track and other related noise above 85 decibels in
9	any octave in the speech range. Other requirements for
10	cabooses are as follows:
11	(a) The trucks shall must provide riding qualities at
12	least equal to those of freight type trucks modified with
13	elliptical or additional coil springs or other means of
14	equal or greater efficiency and shall have at least two
15	four-wheel trucks with standard steel wheels or their
16	equivalent. Draft gears shall must have a minimum travel of
17	2 1/2 inches and a minimum capacity of 18,000 foot-pounds
18	and shall comply with Association of American Railroads
19	Standard M-901 or its equivalent.

(b) Electric lighting of at least 40 foot-candles shall must be provided for direct illumination of the caboose

(c) A spotlight shall must be provided on the rear of

the caboose with sufficient candlepower to illuminate the

track for a distance of at least 300 feet to the rear of the

desk, reading areas, and lavatory facilities.



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caboose during the hours of darkness.

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- (d.) The caboose marker or markers shall must be either reflectorized or capable of illumination when required.
- (a) Only glass of the safety-glass type that may be used in partitions, doors, windows, or wind deflectors.
- (f) All seats and seat backs shall must conform to the safety standards designated by the United States department of transportation in its "Pederal Motor Wehicle Safety Standards", Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 201. All edges and protrusions on seats and seat backs shall must be sounded to prevent injury to employees.
- (9+(2) Any A person, corporation, or company, operating any railroad or railway in this state, violating any of the provisions of this section and 69-14-233 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$500 or more than \$1,000 for each offense."
- NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

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
