In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0050, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill to eliminate the Department of Revenue's responsibility to issue tax-paid decals for campers.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Administrative duties will not noticeably change under the proposed legislation. The department will continue to be responsible for providing county offices with decals. However, each county treasurer will be responsible for issuance of the decals for taxpayer convenience.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No appreciable impact.

EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

There is no appreciable fiscal impact. Although the county treasurers will be responsible for issuance of the decals, they will no longer be responsible for transmitting applications to the Department of Revenue.
