(7)(8) "Department" means the department of revenue.

6 (8)(9) "Immediate family" means a spouse, dependent
7 children, or dependent parents.

8 (9)(10) "Import" means to transfer beer or table wine
9 from outside the state of Montana into the state of Montana.
10 (10)(11) "Industrial use" means a use described as
11 industrial use by the federal Alcohol Administration Act and
12 the federal rules and regulations of 27 CFR.

13 (11) "Liquor" means an alcoholic beverage except
14 beer and table wine.

15 (12)(13) "Malt beverage" means an alcoholic beverage 16 made by the fermentation of an infusion or decoction, or a 17 combination of both, in potable brewing water, of malted 18 barley with or without hops or their parts or their products 19 and with or without other malted cereals and with or without 20 the addition of unmalted or prepared cereals, other 21 carbohydrates, or products prepared therefrom and with or 22 without other wholesome products suitable for human food 23 consumption.

24 (13)(14) "Package" means a container or receptable used 25' for holding an alcoholic beverage.

1 (14)(15) "Posted price" means the retail price of liquor 2 and table wine as fixed and determined by the department and 3 in addition thereto an excise and license tax as provided in 4 this code.

5 (15)(16) "Proof gallon" means a U.S. gallon of liquor at
6 60 degrees on the Fahrenheit scale that contains 50% of
7 alcohol by volume.

8 (±6)(17) "Public place" means a place, building, or
9 conveyance to which the public has or may be permitted to
10 have access and any place of public resort.

11 (17)(18) "Rules" means rules published by the department 12 pursuant to this code.

13 (10)(19) "State liquor facility" means a facility owned 14 or under control of the department for the purpose of 15 receiving, storing, transporting, or selling alcoholic 16 beverages.

17 (19)(20) "State liquor store" means a retail store operated by the department in accordance with this code for the purpose of selling liquor and table wine.

20 (20)(21) "Storage depot" means a building or structure 21 owned or operated by a brewer at any point in the state of 22 Montana off and away from the premises of a brewery, and 23 which structure is equipped with refrigeration or cooling 24 apparatus for the storage of beer and from which a brewer 25 may sell or distribute beer as permitted by this code. 1 (21)(22) "Subwarehouse" means a building or structure
2 owned or operated by a licensed beer wholesaler or table
3 wine distributor, located at a site in Montana other than
4 the site of such beer wholesaler's or table wine
5 distributor's warehouse or principal place of business, and
6 used for the receiving, storage, and distribution of beer or
7 table wine as permitted by this code.

8 (22)(23) "Table wine" means wine as defined below which
9 contains not more than 16% alcohol by volume.

10 (23)(24) "Warehouse" means a building or structure 11 located in Montana owned or operated by a licensed beer 12 wholesaler or table wine distributor for the receiving, 13 storage, and distribution of beer or table wine as permitted 14 by this code.

15 (24)(25) "Wine" means an alcoholic beverage made from or 16 containing the normal alcoholic fermentation of the juice of 17 sound, ripe fruit or other agricultural products without 18 addition or abstraction, except as may occur in the usual 19 cellar treatment of clarifying and aging, and that contains 20 more than 0.5% but not more than 24% of alcohol by volume. 21 Wine may be ameliorated to correct natural deficiencies, 22 sweetened, and fortified in accordance with applicable 23 federal regulations and the customs and practices of the 24 industry. Other alcoholic beverages not defined as above but 25 made in the manner of wine and labeled and sold as wine in

accordance with federal regulations are also wine."
 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Sales hours -- agency stores
 near national parks. Agency stores within 15 miles of a
 national park boundary may operate and sell liquor and table
 wine on Sundays and state holidays during the summer tourist
 season of June, July, August, and September.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction.
[Section 2] is intended to be codified as an integral part
of Title 16, chapter 2, part 1, and the provisions of Title
16, chapter 2, part 1, apply to [section 2].
