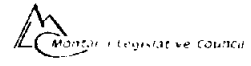

 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING THE FORMULA
 5 PERTAINING TO FEDERAL AND STATE MATCHING FUNDS FOR MEDICAL
 6 RESEARCH FACILITY CONSTRUCTION, EQUIPMENT, AND STARTUP
 7 OPERATING COSTS; EXTENDING THE TERMINATION DATE OF THE
 8 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COAL SEVERANCE TAX PERMANENT
 9 FUND TO BE USED FOR THE MEDICAL RESEARCH FACILITY PROJECTS
 10 TO JUNE 30, 1993; AMENDING SECTION 90-3-901, MCA, AND
 11 SECTION 1, CHAPTER 634, LAWS OF 1989; AND PROVIDING AN
 12 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 15 **Section 1.** Section 90-3-901, MCA, is amended to read:
 16 "90-3-901. Medical research facility projects account
 17 -- allocation of funds -- goals and criteria -- rulemaking.
 18 (1) There is a medical research facility projects account in
 19 the state special revenue fund into which must be deposited
 20 the money appropriated in section 1, Chapter 634, Laws of
 21 1989.
 22 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of Title 90, chapter
 23 3, the Montana science and technology development board may
 24 award grants of the money appropriated under section 1,
 25 Chapter 634, Laws of 1989, for the purposes described in

1 that section.
 2 (3) The board may award a grant to a medical research
 3 facility project if the project proposal meets the following
 4 goals:
 5 (a) The project is designed to establish an advanced
 6 medical research facility that will be funded sufficiently
 7 to become an enduring research presence in the state.
 8 (b) The project concentrates on fields of medical
 9 research that involve advanced technology applied to
 10 national medical concerns.
 11 (c) The project is designed to recruit and retain in
 12 the state medical researchers of nationally recognized
 13 stature.
 14 (4) The board, at a minimum, shall use the following
 15 criteria in awarding a medical research facility grant:
 16 (a) State funds for construction, equipment, and
 17 startup operating costs must be matched on at least a
 18 four-to-one 2 1/2-to-1 federal-to-state matching basis with
 19 federal funds appropriated for the same purpose.
 20 (b) The project proposal includes an effective
 21 construction and operating plan that provides a sound basis
 22 for ongoing operation of the facility.
 23 (c) The personnel, equipment, and research operation of
 24 the facility are sufficient to earn and maintain a
 25 nationally recognized stature.

1 (5) The board may adopt rules to implement the purposes
2 of section 1, Chapter 634, Laws of 1989, and this section."

3 **Section 2.** Section 1, Chapter 634, Laws of 1989, is
4 amended to read:

5 "Section 1. **Appropriation.** There is appropriated from
6 the income and earnings on the coal severance tax permanent
7 fund that otherwise would be appropriated to the coal
8 severance tax permanent fund under 17-5-704 the amount of \$2
9 million to the medical research facility projects account
10 established in [section 2] for the biennium ending June 30,
11 ~~1991~~ 1993. The money is to be used to match federally
12 appropriated funds on at least a ~~four-to-one~~ 2 1/2-to-1
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14 and startup operating costs for medical research facility
15 projects in the state. The Montana science and technology
16 development board shall administer the appropriation."

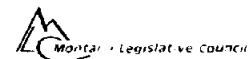
17 NEW SECTION. **Section 3.** Effective date. [This act] is

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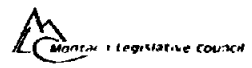
