DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill repeals the annual audit requirement for the agricultural loan authority.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Montana Agricultural Loan Authority (MALA) and Beginning Farm Loan Program will remain inactive or enabling statutes will be repealed. Therefore there will be no resulting bond issuance or other activities.
- 2. The legislative auditor will include the MALA as a part of the Department of Agriculture's audit at no additional expense.


