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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 82-11-143, MCA, is amended to read:

"82-11-143. Rehearing. A person adversely affected by a rule or order of the board may within 20 days after its effective date apply to the board in writing for a rehearing. The application for rehearing shall must be acted upon within-10-days at the board's next regularly scheduled meeting after its filing of the application, and if granted, the rehearing shall must be held without undue delay."

Section 2. Section 82-11-149, MCA, is amended to read:

3	\$57888 not more than $$10,000$ a day for each violation if

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0225, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill: 1) revises the laws relating to the administration of the oil and gas conservation laws by the Board of Oil and Gas Conservation: 2) clarifies the authority of the board to conduct rehearings on rules or orders issued by the board; and 3) revises the civil penalty to not more than \$10,000 a day for a violation of a rule or order of the board or of a provision of Title 82, chapter 11, MCA.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The proposed amendment provides an enforcement tool by allowing more flexibility to assess a civil penalty commensurate with the severity of a violation of Board of Oil and Gas Conservation rules.
- 2. The bill is not intended to supplement revenues received by the board.
- 3. Historically no revenue has been collected from this section of the code.
