 8 EXPANSION; AND AMENDING SECTION 37-1-131, MCA."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 **Section 1.** Section 37-1-131, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "37-1-131. Duties of boards. Each board within the
 13 department shall:

14 (1) set and enforce standards and rules governing the
 15 licensing, certification, registration, and conduct of the
 16 members of the particular profession or occupation within
 17 its jurisdiction;

18 (2) sit in judgment in hearings for the suspension,
 19 revocation, or denial of a license of an actual or potential
 20 member of the particular profession or occupation within its
 21 jurisdiction. The hearings shall be conducted by legal
 22 counsel when required under 37-1-121(1).

23 (3) pay to the department its pro rata share of the
 24 assessed costs of the department under 37-1-101(6);

25 (4) consult with the department before the board

1 initiates a program expansion, under existing legislation,
 2 to determine if the board has adequate money and
 3 appropriation authority to fully pay all costs associated
 4 with the proposed program expansion. The board may not
 5 expand a program if the board does not have adequate money
 6 and appropriation authority available."
