In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0276, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act requiring payment of partial salary to a firefighter injured in the performance of duty.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. A member of a fire department of a first or second class municipality injured in the performance of duty must be paid by the municipality the difference between his full salary and the amount received from workers' compensation until the disability has ceased.
- 2. The proposed legislation will not change the amount of workers' compensation currently paid to an eligible firefighter.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None

EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

Personal service costs in first and second class municipalities would increase above the amount currently paid when a firefighter is injured while performing his/her duties and subsequently becomes eligible for workers' compensation.
