In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0307, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:


An act revising the Board of Dentistry by adding a fifth dentist; requiring that one of the dentists on the board serve as a nonvoting member of the board.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The Board of Dentistry will increase from eight to nine members. The board will meet six times per year. Each meeting will last one day. Travel cost is \$100 per meeting per member.
2. License fees currently charged by the board are sufficient to absorb the increased cost caused by the proposed legislation.
3. Current law is represented by the Board of Dentistry of the Department of Commerce.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 **Section 1.** Section 2-15-1842, MCA, is amended to read:

14 "2-15-1842. Board of dentistry. (1) There is a board of
15 dentistry.

16 (2) (a) The board consists of four five dentists, one
17 of whom shall serve as a nonvoting member, one denturist,
18 one dental hygienist, and two public members, one of whom
19 must be a senior citizen. All members are appointed by the
20 governor with the consent of the senate. ~~The board shall~~
21 ~~designate which of the dentists on the board is the~~
22 ~~nonvoting member.~~ Each licensed member shall be licensed to
23 practice as a dentist, denturist, or dental hygienist in
24 this state, shall have actively practiced in this state for
25 at least 5 continuous years immediately before his

1 appointment, except as provided in subsection (2)(b), and
2 shall be actively engaged in practice while serving on the
3 board. Each member shall be a resident of this state.

4 (b) The provision in subsection (2)(a) requiring a
5 licensed member to have actively practiced in this state for
6 at least 5 continuous years immediately before his
7 appointment does not apply to the first denturist appointed
8 to the board.

9 (3) Each member shall serve for a term of 5 years. The
10 governor may remove a member only for neglect or cause.

11 (4) The governor shall fill any vacancy within 30 days.

12 (5) The board is allocated to the department for
13 administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121."

14 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is
15 effective January 1, 1992.
