In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0307, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act revising the Board of Dentistry by adding a fifth dentist; requiring that one of the dentists on the board serve as a nonvoting member of the board.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The Board of Dentistry will increase from eight to nine members. The board will meet six times per year. Each meeting will last one day. Travel cost is \$100 per meeting per member.
- 2. License fees currently charged by the board are sufficient to absorb the increased cost caused by the proposed legislation.
- 3. Current law is represented by the Board of Dentistry of the Department of Commerce.
