A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW A PERSON TO USE FORCE LIKELY TO CAUSE DEATH OR SERIOUS BODILY HARM IN ORDER TO PREVENT SEXUAL INTERCOURSE WITHOUT CONSENT, DEVIATE SEXUAL CONDUCT WITHOUT CONSENT, OR THE IMMINENT THREAT OF EITHER CRIME; AND AMENDING SECTION 45-3-102, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 45-3-102, MCA, is amended to read:

"45-3-102. Use of force in defense of person. A person is justified in the use of force or threat to use force against another when and to the extent that he reasonably believes that such the conduct is necessary to defend himself or another against such the other's imminent use of unlawful force. However, he is justified in the use of force likely to cause death or serious bodily harm only if:

(1) he reasonably believes that such the force is necessary to prevent imminent death or serious bodily harm to himself or another;

(2) the force is or to prevent the commission of a forcible felony; or

(3) the force is to prevent sexual intercourse without consent, deviate sexual conduct without consent, or the
