BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 13-37-102, MCA, is amended to read:

"13-37-102. Creation of office. (1) There is a commissioner of political practices who is appointed by the governor chief justice of the Montana supreme court, subject to confirmation by a majority of the senate. A four-member selection committee comprised of the speaker of the house, the president of the senate, and the minority floor leaders of both houses of the legislature shall submit to the governor chief justice a list of not less than two or more than five names of individuals for his consideration. A majority of the members of the selection committee shall agree upon each nomination.

(2) The individual selected to serve as commissioner of political practices may be removed by the governor chief justice prior to the expiration of the term only for incompetence, malfeasance, or neglect of duty. The
