In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB0363, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act revising the law governing horseracing; expanding the types of simulcast races that the Board of Horseracing may approve; authorizing licensees to withhold an additional 1% on exotic wagering; amending sections 23-4-301 and 23-4-302; and providing an immediate effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The proposed legislation allows Montana businesses to engage in parimutuel betting by patrons on the results of simulcast races approved by the Board of Horseracing.
- 2. The proposed legislation increases the amount retained by the licensee from exotic wagering from 24% to 25% of total deposits. In all other races, the amount retained by the licensee may not exceed 20% of the total deposits. The only time the 25% maximum retainment would apply is during parimutuel betting on simulcast races with a host track whose percentage on exotic wagering is 25%.
- 3. Each licensee conducting a parimutuel betting on simulcast races will retain an additional 1% of the deposits from exotic wagering for the Montana Simulcast Partners. Montana Simulcast Partners is a nonprofit organization which distributes profits to tracks conducting live racing per the provisions of 23-4-301(6), MCA.
- 4. The additional 1% of the deposits from parimutuel betting will be approximately \$15,000 per year.
