(1) A judgment debtor is entitled to exemption 13 14 from execution of the following: 15 (a) professionally prescribed health aids for the judgment debtor or a dependent of the judgment debtor; 16 17 (b) benefits the judgment debtor has received or is entitled to receive under federal social security or local 18 19 public assistance legislation, except as provided in 20 subsection (2); 21 (c) veterans' benefits, provided except as in subsection (2); 22 (d) disability or illness benefits; 23 24 (e) benefits paid or payable for medical, surgical, or hospital care to the extent they are used or will be used to 25

3	(g) a burial plot for the judgment debtor and his

5	(h) all property in this state of the judgment debtor

9	(2) Veterans' and social security legislation benefits
10	based upon remuneration for employment, as defined in 42
11	U.S.C. 662(f), are not exempt from execution if the debt for

14	(b) maintenance to be paid to a spouse or former spouse
15	if the spouse or former spouse is the custodial parent of a
16	child for whom child support is owed or owing and the
