 14 as prepared by the county registrar, and make a list of the  
 15 names of all persons qualified to serve as trial jurors, as  
 16 prescribed in part 3 of this chapter. Each name so appearing  
 17 on said list shall be assigned a number which shall be  
 18 placed opposite the name on the jury list and shall be  
 19 considered the number of the juror opposite whose name it  
 20 appears. Said numbers shall be consecutive from "1" to the  
 21 total number of jurors. A person's name may not appear on a  
 22 jury list for more than one court during a 1-year term."
