Food, Agriculture, Conservation and Trade Act of 1990. 3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE 5 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 6 That the members of the Montana Congressional Delegation be urged to call for the immediate revisiting of the federal Food, Agriculture, Conservation and Trade Act of 1990 for the purpose of strengthening legislation that will improve 10 net farm income, thereby promoting development of Montana's 11 rural and urban economies. 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send 13 a copy of this resolution to each member of the Montana 14 Congressional Delegation.
