Terms of Use

1. I have reviewed and will abide by all of the requirements found in the Montana Courts Temporary Electronic Filing Rules.
2. I agree to follow all applicable statutes, rules, regulations, and court orders, including without limitation the Montana Rules of Civil Procedure [and/or the Rules of Appellate Procedure](#) in the submission of electronic documents.
3. I will abide by the requirements of the Montana Courts Temporary Electronic Filing Rule 3, Registration Requirements, including Rules 3(c), agreeing to electronic notification on any case electronically filed, and 3(e), keeping registration information current.
4. I have reviewed and understand the Montana Courts Temporary Electronic Filing Rule 9, Official Record.
5. I will abide by the requirements of the Montana Courts Temporary Electronic Filing Rule 6, Filing and Service of Subsequent Documents, including Rules 6(d), electronic notice of service and 6(e) proof of service.
6. I will abide by the requirements of the Montana Courts Temporary Electronic Filing Rule 11, Confidential Information including 11(a), the confidentiality of an electronic record, is the same as for the equivalent paper record, and 11(b) if a document is deemed confidential by statute, local rules or court order, it shall be identified as confidential by the submitting party when it is filed.
7. I have reviewed and understand the paper filing requirements of the Montana Courts Temporary Electronic Filing Rule 12, Electronically Filing Documents in a Case on Appeal.
8. I agree that all reasonable steps will be taken to ensure that the document does not contain defective or malicious computer code that might be harmful or damaging to the E-Filing System. Additionally, the electronic filer will not take any action that might damage or compromise the security of the E-Filing System or website, or render the system inaccessible by other users.
9. I understand that technical failures caused by my own hardware, software, phone or internet lines will not generally excuse an untimely filing.
10. The Court may suspend or discontinue the Electronic Filer's access to the E-Filing System in order to protect its security or to prevent damage, misuse, or fraud.
