

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
TAXATION COMMITTEE

April 15, 1987

The meeting of the Taxation Committee was called to order by Chairman Ramirez on April 15, 1987, at 9 a.m., in Room 312B of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All members were present. Also present was Dave Bohyer, Researcher, Legislative Council.

CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 56: Rep. Bob Gilbert, House District #22, sponsor of HJR 56, said the bill would require an interim study of strengthening the gasoline license tax collection procedures, the results of which would be reported to the 51st Legislature.

Rep. Gilbert stated SB 116 was an unfair bill, and made a motion that the amendments form SB 51 be added to page 1, line 16, of HJR 56. The motion CARRIED unanimously.

PROPOSERS OF HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 56: Janelle Fallan, Montana Petroleum Association, stated her support of the bill.

OPPOSERS OF HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 56: There were no opposers of the bill.

QUESTIONS ON HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 56: There were no questions on the bill.

CLOSING ON HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 56: Rep. Gilbert made no closing comments.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 56: Rep. Gilbert made a motion that HJR 56 DO PASS AS AMENDED. The motion CARRIED unanimously.
