

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
LONG RANGE PLANNING SUBCOMMITTEE
50TH LEGISLATIVE SESSION

The meeting of the Long Range Planning Subcommittee was called to order by Chairman Rep. Robert Thoft on February 19, 1987 at 8:00 a.m., in Room 202B of the State Capitol.

Executive Session

Grant #1 Upper Blackfoot River Streambank Reclamation
Grant #5 Snowshoe Creek Streambank Reclamation
Grant #9 Nellis Grant Mine Reclamation:

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to APPROVE grants #1, 5, and 9 as recommended with the contingency that the cost of ground water monitoring be limited to \$7,000 or less after the preliminary reconnaissance. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Sen. Van Valkenburg said all contingencies are included with the approval of projects.

Grant #3 Clark Fork Monitoring: (090)

Action: Sen. Walker MOVED to APPROVE grant #3 as recommended. Sen. Walker withdrew his motion.

Grant #4 High Ore Creek Reclamation Project:

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to APPROVE as recommended. Sen. Van Valkenburg amended the MOTION to APPROVE grant #4 at \$198,600. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #6 Plug - Wilkstrand Simer Well #1:

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to APPROVE \$19,951 for grant #6. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #7 Bannack State Park-Apex
Mill Hazardous Waste Clean up: (190)

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to APPROVE grant #7 for \$101,200 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #8 Reclamation for Past Oil and
Gas Extraction, Exploration, and Processing:

Action: Sen. Aklestad MOVED to APPROVE grant #8 for \$150,000 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #10 Abandoned Oil Refineries in Montana: (225)

Action: Sen. Walker MOVED to APPROVE grant #10 for \$300,000 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED with Sen. Aklestad voting no.

Grant #11 Cataract Creek Reclamation Project: (267)

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to APPROVE grant #11 for \$21,565 as recommended with the contingency being that they contribute at least \$1,135, if more I-15 funds become available they will be paid first. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Clark Fork River Projects: (365)

Howard Johnson, Governors Office, said there is an inter-agency task force on the Clark Fork River. Mr. Johnson said the Governor intends for this to be a four year project. He said they are two years into the project.

Grant #3 Clark Fork Monitoring: (500)

Action: Sen. Walker MOVED to APPROVE \$205,590 for grant #3. The MOTION CARRIED unaimously.

Grant #17 Montana Salinity Control Program:

Action: Sen. McLane MOVED to APPROVE grant #17 for \$300,000 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #12 Reserve Pit and Oilfield Brine Disposal Assessment:

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to APPROVE grant #12 for \$100,000 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #13 Plug Sunburst Disotell Well #1
Grant #14 Plug Well Leaking Gas, Gas City Field: (184)

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to APPROVE grants #13 for \$55,000 and #14 for \$46,330 as recommended with the contingency that bids be taken. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #15 Montana State Library: (219)

Action: Rep. Bardanoue MOVED to APPROVE grant #15 for \$177,970 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED with Sen. Aklestad voting no.

Grant #16 Water Resources Center, UM: (321)

Discussion: Caralee Cheney, DNRC, said this project will not be funded until EPA says that it is not a Superfund site.

Action: Sen. Van Valkenburg MOVED to APPROVE grant #16 as recommended. The MOTION FAILED with Sen. Van Valkenburg and Rep. Bardanoue voting yes.

Grant #18 Berkeley Pit Reindustrialization and Mineral Recovery: (412)

Action: Sen. Aklestad MOVED to NOT APPROVE grant #18. The MOTION CARRIED with Sen. Van Valkenburg voting no.

Grant #19 Anselmo Mine Yard Reclamation Project:

Action: Rep. Bardanoue MOVED to APPROVE grant #19 for \$75,000 with the contingency that ARCO reclaim the land. The MOTION CARRIED with Sen. Van Valkenburg voting no.

Grant #20 Groundwater From Abandoned Mine workings For Irrigation and Instream Flows, Lower Musselshell River:

Action: Rep. Bardanoue MOVED to APPROVE grant #20 for \$272,320 with the contingency that \$30,000 be used for management of the water monitoring. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #22 Sodium and Salinity Sources in the Powder River Basin, A Chemical - Budget, Modeling Approach:

Action: Sen. Van Valkenburg MOVED to APPROVE grant #22 for \$89,257 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #23 Drill Hole Reclamation in Montana Hole Plugging Trials Utilizing Bentonite:

Action: Rep. Bardanoue MOVED to APPROVE grant #23 for \$100,000 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED with Sen. Aklestad voting no.

Grant #24 Montana's Accelerated Soil Survey Program: (084)

Action: Sen. Van Valkenburg MOVED TO APPROVE grant #24 for \$300,000 as recommended. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #25 Clark Fork Reclamation Demonstration
for Floodplan Systems Impacted by Minting: (120)

Action: Sen. Van Valkenburg MOVED to APPROVE grant #25 for \$130,000. The MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

Grant #26 DNRC:

Action: Rep. Bardanouve MOVED to NOT APPROVE grant #26. Rep. Bardanouve withdrew his motion.
