

MEETING MINUTES  
HUMAN SERVICES SUBCOMMITTEE  
MARCH 3, 1987

The meeting of the human services subcommittee was called to order at 8:05 a.m. on March 3, 1987 in room 108 of the state capitol building by Chairman Cal Winslow.

ROLL CALL: Sen Manning was absent, all other members were present.

HOUSE BILL 460 - AN ACT PERMANENTLY INCREASING THE FEE FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE; PROVIDING FOR FEE DISPOSITION, ETC.

(54a:406) Rep Nancy Keenan, house district 66, introduced this bill that would increase the dissolution of marriage fee to \$100.00 and be distributed as follows: \$35.00 for the Big Brothers and Sisters Program, \$40.00 for the Displaced Homemaker Program, and \$25.00 for District Courts (county general fund).

PROPONENTS

Judy Carlson, Big Brothers and Sisters Program, spoke in support of the bill and its funding of the Big Brothers and Sisters Program.

(54a:496) Cindy Stergar, Butte Displaced Homemaker Program, spoke briefly in support of the bill and the funding for the Displaced Homemaker Program.

Sandy Chaney, Womens Lobbyist Fund, spoke in support of funding all the displaced homemaker programs in operation in the state.

Discussion followed on the fee allocation, the district court funding, and clarification of the bill for committee members.

(54a:660) Rep Keenan closed testimony on House Bill 460.

EXECUTIVE ACTION

HOUSE BILL 460 - AN ACT PERMANENTLY INCREASING THE FEE FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE; PROVIDING FOR FEE DISPOSITION, ETC.

Rep Bradley made a motion that House Bill 460 DO PASS.

A voice vote was taken and the motion PASSED unanimously, with Sen Manning absent.

HOUSE BILL 373 - AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION TO EMPLOY NECESSARY STAFF TO ENSURE TIMELY PROCESSING OF CLAIMS, ETC.

(54b:077) Rep Connelly made a motion that House Bill 373 DO PASS.

A voice vote was taken and the motion PASSED, with Rep Switzer voting no and Sen Manning absent.

HOUSE BILL 538 - AN ACT REORGANIZING THE DELIVERY OF HUMAN SERVICES BY STATE GOVERNMENT, ETC.

(54b:116) Rep Bradley made a motion that House Bill 538 DO PASS.

A voice vote was taken and the motion PASSED, with Sen Himsl voting no and Sen Manning absent.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 a.m. (54b:189).
