

MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
HIGHWAYS & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE  
MONTANA STATE SENATE

April 22, 1987

The meeting of the Highways and Transportation Committee was called to order at 2:30 p.m., April 22, 1987, by Chairman Larry Tveit in Room 410 of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All members of the Highways and Transportation Committee were present except Senator Williams and Senator Weeding.

CONSIDERATION ON HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 57: Representative Harper spoke on behalf of Representative Fritz who was the sponsor of House Joint Resolution No. 57. Representative Harper stated that House Joint Resolution would request an interim study of the potential economic growth through tourism development requiring a report to the 51st Legislature.

He spoke about his recent trip to the Maverick Mountain ski area over the break of the Legislature where there was great skiing and only a few skiers. By categorizing tourist information and mailing the brochures nationwide, we could introduce Montana to residents of Los Angeles and New York and tell them about the great state of Montana. He also spoke about preparing for the Olympics that are being held in Alberta, Canada, and that we could, by this study, see if we couldn't draw people through the state of Montana to the 1988 winter olympics.

PROPOSERS: There were none.

OPPOSERS: There were none.

QUESTIONS FROM THE COMMITTEE: The committee discussed the many resolutions that have been introduced this session for interim studies and about categorizing tourism introducing the state of Montana to other states, and if that isn't already being done by the promotion of Montana.

CLOSING: Representative Harper encouraged passage of House Joint Resolution 57 in order to encourage promotion of tourism for the 1988 winter olympics that are being held in Alberta, Canada.

It was moved and seconded that House Joint Resolution No. 57
