HEARING ON SR3

Opening Statement by Sponsor:

SEN. THOMAS KEATING, Senate District 5, Billings, stated that the ANNE FRANK IN THE WORLD: 1929-1945 Committee has prepared a museum-quality exhibit which is traveling the world. The town of Billings will be honored by having this Exhibit displayed at the Parmly Billings Library from March 6 through April 8, 1995. SEN. KEATING said that Montana has been nationally recognized for its resistance to discrimination. SR3 thanks the Anne Frank in

the World Committee for bringing this Exhibit to Montana, and SR3 states that Montana will continue its goal to oppose discrimination.

SEN. MACK COLE, asked Senator Keating if Billings is the only place in Montana where the Exhibit can be seen. SEN.
