EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HB 75

Motion:

Mr. Kakuk said he had conversed with Department of Health and Evironmental Services (DHES) personnel and was told that the amendments did not have any significant affect on HB 75 and the department would not oppose them. Mr. Kakuk said he faxed a copy of the amendment to Mark Staley, Attorney, DHES, but had not heard from him. He noted that Mr. Staley was present in the audience. Question was called. Voice vote was taken. Motion to amend HB 75 carried unanimously.


Motion/Vote:
