



Pending Cases in Quarter 3 of 2017 was not captured.


## 3rd Quarter 2017 Highlights

- \* Time to Disposition for Original Proceedings for Original Proceedings increased from 48 days in Q2 to 182 days in Q3.
- \* Time to Disposition for Direct Appeals increased very minimally in Q3 over Q2.
- $\mbox{*}$  Case Clearance rates dropped slightly in Q3 2017 from 103% to 89%.

Case Clearance: The ratio between the number of cases closed (outgoing) and the number of cases filed (incoming).

Manner of Disposition: The manner by which the Court disposes of its cases.

**Age of Pending Cases:** The age of the Court's active cases (does not include stayed cases). **Time to Disposition:** The length of time (median days) it takes the Court to dispose of cases.
