On March 22, 2023, the Defendant was sentenced as follows:

<u>Count I</u>: Five (5) years to the Montana State Prison for the offense of Criminal Possession of Dangerous Drugs (Methamphetamine), a Felony, in violation of §45-9-102(1), MCA. The Court recommended the Defendant be screened for Chemical Dependency and Mental Health Treatment.

Count VI: One (1) year to the Lewis and Clark County Jail for the offense of Fleeing from or Eluding Peace Officer, a Misdemeanor, in violation of §61-8-316(1), MCA.

The Court dismissed Counts II, III, IV, and V. The Defendant was given credit for time served for the following date ranges: July 19, 2021 through March 22, 2023. The sentences imposed were ordered to run concurrently with each other and concurrently to the sentence imposed upon the Defendant in Case No. DDC-21-538, Lewis and Clark County District Court.

On November 1, 2023, the Defendant's Application for review of that sentence came on for hearing by Zoom videoconference before the Sentence Review Division of the Montana Supreme Court (hereafter "the Division"). The Defendant appeared from the Dawson County Correctional Facility and was represented by Rufus Peace, Defense Counsel. The State was not represented. Joe Cartwright was present but did not provide a statement. The Defendant did not give a statement.

Before hearing the Application, the Defendant was advised that the Division has the authority not only to reduce the sentence or affirm it, but also increase it. The Defendant was further advised that there is no appeal from a decision of the Division. The Defendant

acknowledged that he understood this and stated that he wished to proceed.

Rule 12, Rules of the Sentence Review Division of the Supreme Court of Montana, provides that, "The sentence imposed by the District Court is presumed correct. The sentence shall not be reduced or increased unless it is clearly inadequate or clearly excessive." (Section 46-18-904(3), MCA).

The Division finds that the reasons advanced for modification are insufficient to hold that the sentence imposed by the District Court is clearly inadequate or clearly excessive.

Therefore, it is the unanimous decision of the Division that the sentence is AFFIRMED.
