The Finance and Claims Committee met in Special session in room 108 of the State Capitol on the above date. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Regan at 2:35 A.M. following roll call.


ROLL CALL: All members present except Senator Aklestad who was absent and Senator Smith who was excused.

CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE BILL 1: Representative Bardanoue explained the bill as the appropriation for the special session which was prepared by the Legislative Council and based on the previous special sessions. The bill was amended in Appropriation Committee where they removed some money. It was proposed that two committees, Finance and Claims and Appropriations and the Revenue Committees would meet Thursday Evening. The Finance and Claims and Appropriations did not do so, therefore the committee had the funding removed. Both houses were treated the same, we could not justify the other day with no meeting. The Legislative Council has prepared a budget comparison (passed out to the committee and attached as exhibit 1) which will be changed because of the amendment in Appropriation Committee. This is the cost of the session for the House, the Senate, the Council and the salaries and per diem. If it goes more than one day there will have to be a supplemental.

There were no further proponents, no opponents, no questions from the committee.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL 1: Motion by Senator Haffey that House Bill 1 be approved. Voted, passed.
